

Maltese for Foreigners – Beginners' Course - Starting 22nd March 2019

Course: 12 sessions of 3 hours each per week - 36 tuition hours and another 36 hours of individual study, conversation sessions.

Content: The course includes: The Maltese alphabet: Consonants and Vowels; Articles and Prepositions; Verbs; Gender, Nouns and Adjectives; Singular and Plural; Present, Past and Future Tenses; Negatives; Suffixes; Numbers and Time; Salutations; Conversation.

Target participants: Foreigners living/staying/working in Malta and Gozo. Must be 21 years old on 1st March 2019.

Objectives: To acquire a basic knowledge of the Maltese language for everyday life: street, shopping, work, leisure and more; To develop capacity of listening, speaking, reading and writing Maltese based on its grammar; To have fun while learning another useful language.

Sessions: Once weekly (every Friday) between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. (except public holidays). Starting Friday 22 March 2019. Any extra sessions held beyond the 12 weeks of the course will be free of charge.

Course language is English. Participants must at least be able to communicate in simple everyday English.

Course fee: €180 (inclusive of beverage and nibble during break). Duly filled in and signed application forms may be sent by email to info@birmula.com or handed in personally by Sunday 10th March 2019 (noon). The fee must be settled on the first lesson day. The venue will be open on Saturdays and Sundays between 10:00 am and 12:00 noon or during the week (evenings) by prior appointment.

Course Venue: Bir Mula Heritage museum, 79, St. Margerita Street, Bormla (Cospicua)

Certificate: A 'Certificate of Attendance' will be issued to all participants attending more than 80% of the sessions and presenting homework exercises as requested.

Assessment: Participants success and development will be assessed throughout the sessions based on active participation during the lesson, in conversation sessions and homework.

Materials: The materials required for the course are: § A copy book for taking notes, class-work and home-work; § Blue ink ball-pen § Red ink ball pen § Pencil § Plastic ruler § Eraser § Pencil sharpener § Course Text book.*

** Note: DO NOT buy any text-books or dictionaries before the first lesson.*

Intake opens on Saturday 1st December 2018 (10am) till Sunday 10th March 2019 (noon).
